About the Founder



Fay Maddison is a mother, business woman, PTSD survivor, writer, artist, daughter of a WW11 PTSD soldier, and Navy wife of 27 years.

Drawing on her experience as a daughter of a soldier struggling with PTSD and her later own personal struggle with the same condition, Fay knows first-hand the impact that this disorder can have on a family- especially the children. PTSD is a disorder that affects many of those who put their lives on the line each day to protect us and to come to our aid in our most desperate of times. However, it is not widely acknowledged therefore leaving emergency personnel and their family suffering in silence.

Fay felt that the best way she could give back to those families that SERVE and PROTECT our children and our lives everyday was to launch the Natasha's Wood Foundation:

Supporting children through the ARTS, EDUCATION and SPORTS.

Founder's Vision

Fay had been hired by DND/ OSISS due to her High-Functioning PTSD understanding, yet felt that there was still a great piece of the healing puzzle that had not been identified - nor acknowledged; The CHILDREN - of those that SERVE and PROTECT. This is the first and foremost purpose of the Natasha's Wood Foundation: to serve the **children** of those who serve.



Foundation Vision - Our vision is to create a living legacy for quality of life programs for all children of injured First Responders who answered the call to serve and protect us.

Mission Statement - Natasha's Wood Foundation

Through a "Legacy for Life", the Natasha's Wood Foundation will harness the power of story-telling, the arts, education and sports to generate awareness of and unconditional support for the mental wellness of children in First Responder and Military families that have been adversely affected by service to community and country.



*** Families (especially those families living with a family member (parent)/ (guardian) that has served/is serving and has an injury (OSI/ PTSD/ TBI). These are the "families" that are our PRIORITY. Living with a family member that may have difficulty being "employed" because of their "injury (TBI/ OSI/ PTSD) lowers the "quality of life" financially to these families. Often the other Parent/ partner has to become the "caregiver" -- therefore loss of income impedes this families livelihood financially and / quality of life, (due to service to country) and the entire family are affected especially the children.
